About the Program

Judge Sundermann will explore the nature of political trials and their significance within our society through discussion of the trial of Al Capone.

One of the most notorious gangsters in American history, Al Capone's Prohibition-Era Chicago crime syndicate flourished as the country entered the Great Depression. The syndicate's activities were believed to include bootlegging, promoting prostitution, election fixing, extortion and murder. Thanks to charitable activities financed through his ill-gotten gains, Capone was viewed by many as a modern-day Robin Hood. The government's attempts to bring him to justice ultimately resulted only in an indictment for tax evasion in 1931. After Capone's attempts to bribe and intimidate jurors in his case were thwarted, the trial went on to result in Capone's conviction of tax evasion and sentencing to eleven years imprisonment. By the time Capone was paroled in 1939, he was in poor health and no longer held sway in the crime world. Despite his death in 1947, the legend of Scarface Al lives on in American lore.
