#### **New Business**

L. Joshua Davidson and Brian Flick discussed the Ohio Supreme Court Case, Taylor v. First Resolution Investment Corporation, et al, 2016 Ohio 3444. This is a lengthy opinion, but a summary was provided (attached). The Ohio Supreme Court has held that filing actions for collection after the running of statutes of limitations have run, and praying for recovery unsubstantiated by the contract are violations of the Fair Debt Collection Practices Act, and the Ohio Consumer Sale Practices Act. This holding was imposed on counsel pursuing collection, notwithstanding counsel's claim that he was not providing goods or services to the parties against whom he was proceeding for his client. This holding leaves judgments subject to attack under Ohio R.Civ.P. 60(b), and as to bankruptcy cases, gives rise to challenges to claims premised on such state court collection judgments.
