# Requirements

- All attorneys must be registered with the Supreme Court of Ohio. No notary commission will be issued until such registration takes place.
- If you live in Kentucky, you can only be an Ohio notary IF your primary place of practice is in Ohio. Kentucky residents should give their Ohio business address rather than their Kentucky residence address.

## **Application Form for the Secretary of State**

Please fill in your name, residence address and sign your name the way it is registered with the Ohio Supreme Court on both of the sections of the blue form. For most attorneys, you will be registered under your full first, middle & last names. Please sign legibly. If you wish to have your commission issued in a different name, you must first change your registration with the Supreme Court. Our office will obtain the Judge's signature.

The application fee is \$80 and includes Secretary of State's office fee.

## **Note for Attorneys**

For Lifetime Notary Publics, it has been recommended by members of the Real Property Committee of the Ohio State Bar Association that the statement noted below be included in the acknowledgment certificate on instruments executed in Ohio involving land in other states. However, as an Attorney, it may be advantageous to have such statement included on all instruments that you may notarize.

#### For the Information of Applicants

- 1. R.C. 147.02 provides that, with respect to the certificate appearing on the reverse of this page, no judge or justice shall issue such a certificate until he or she is satisfied from personal knowledge that the applicant possesses the qualifications necessary to properly discharge the duties of the office. An applicant for commission as an attorney notary public should inquire of the local bar association or the clerk of the court of common pleas, as to the application procedure required by the common pleas court of the appropriate county.
- 2. Complete both portions on this side of the application with your full name and address, including county. If the address is faulty or omitted, the commission cannot reach you.
- 3. R.C. 147.05 provides that, before entering upon the duties of the office, a notary public shall leave his/her commission with that oath endorsed thereon with the clerk of court of common pleas of the appropriate county. The clerk will record and index the commission.
- 4. R.C. 147.03 requires that the Judge's Certificate on the reverse of this form be deposited with the Secretary of State. The Notary Commission Clerk will make such deposit.
- 5. R.C. 147.37 requires that a \$15 fee accompany an application by an attorney admitted to the practice of law in Ohio for appointment as notary public. Please send check or money order payable to "SOS/Notary Commission."

Powers and duties of a notary public are set forth in sections 147.01-147.31, inclusive, of the Ohio Revised Code.

This certificate must be made by a justice of the Ohio Supreme Court, or judge of an Ohio court of appeals or a court of common pleas. (Currently, justices of the supreme court decline to sign such certificates.)
