Famous Political Trials: The Chicago Seven

About the Program

Judge Sundermann will explore the nature of political trials and their significance within our society through discussion of the trial of the “Chicago Seven.”

The trial involved the prosecution of seven anti-war protestors for allegedly conspiring to incite a riot at the 1968 Democratic Convention in Chicago. At trial, defense counsel William Kunstler attempted to put the Vietnam War and the American system of justice on trial, calling well-known singers, artists and activists to testify about what the war protestors found troubling in American society. The trial went on for months, with the National Guard being called in to control crowds of demonstrators. At the conclusion of the trial, all seven defendants were found not guilty of the conspiracy charges, two defendants were completely acquitted, and the remaining defendants were convicted of inciting a riot. But, the convictions were reversed on appeal based on the trial judge’s overt hostility to the defendant and his refusal to permit defense counsel to question jurors regarding cultural bias.
