



PROGRAM

None of us likes to think about growing older and needing help. But we do hope that we will have choices about where and how we will live as we age. Council on Aging of Southwestern Ohio (COA) can start you on the right path; whether you're looking for assistance for a family member, a friend or even yourself. Our goal is to support older adults as they age and help them remain at home while being as independent as possible.

COA support includes programs and information about free and low-cost services available to older adults and caregivers — including in-home care, transportation, home delivered meals, and more. One issue in-home care programs like the Medicaid PASSPORT program sometimes face is a lack of qualified providers for eligible beneficiaries. Attorneys helping clients navigate long-term care eligibility may see delays or difficulties for clients in obtaining in-home care once eligible for PASSPORT. By understanding the process of how COA connects beneficiaries to providers, attorneys will be able to properly set their client's expectations as well as better assist clients in receiving the care they need under the PASSPORT program. During this webinar, COA will share information about available services and how they connect those services to Medicaid PASSPORT beneficiaries.
